HERE I AM LORD

In the first reading today, we hear about Samuel hearing God calling him in the night multiple times, but because Samuel does not yet know God, he thinks the voice is that of the priest, Eli. Reflections on this story often advise us to be like Samuel: to be open to hearing God's voice and discern what we are being told. Although this is true, Samuel would not have heard or understood the prophecy if it wasn't for the wisdom and good counsel of Eli who recognized who was calling Samuel. Eli guided Samuel correctly and raised him up to be a holy man of God and instilled in Samuel a desire and attraction toward God's own heart and will. It is Eli's gifts of wisdom and counsel that aided Samuel's discernment of God's voice. Wisdom and counsel are two of the 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit that we study during Confirmation formation. We are all given these gifts and by 'de-cluttering' our lives we can focus on nurturing these gifts and pursuing God's heart. In doing so, we will better hear God's voice in our lives, calling us to do His will, and we will be better formed disciples of Christ who can help guide others toward the love of the Lord.
